Along with Jamiroquai, M, Suprême NTM, Boys Noise, Julian Casablancas, Toots & The Maytals, the organisers are going to set the trail ablaze. Riding tall in the saddle with their spurs aflashing are Pony Pony Run Run, Midlake, Fanfarlo, FM Belfast, Gush, Sexy Sushi... this ain't no fool's gold, partner... This is the real thing... Each vying to outshine and outsparkle the other.

In 2009, Les Vieilles Charrues were already preparing to open a new route to the Far West - this year they are promising a party that will be about as far out west as you can get, buddy!

Once upon a time in the West ... of Brittany

After a record year in 2009, les Vieilles Charrues have put their hearts into working on the 2010 edition to meet audience expectations. With the whole programme having been released les Vieilles Charrues have shown that they keep their promises. As we head galloping towards the next festival in a cloud of dust to the thundering of hooves, the past must not be forgotten, old values still hold true: we're serious about this partner and I mean serious. But then not TOO serious!

A true marriage of opposites held together in such a masterful way, Les Vieilles Charrues 2010 will once again show that a festival can be both popular and rise to people's expectations of quality, on a huge scale yet retaining its friendly atmosphere, giving the event its uniqueness.

Four days in the wild open spaces of Kerampuilh

Almost 80 acts in Kérampuilh Canyon will set the place ablaze over the four-day event as of Thursday night, **Muse** and their spectacular show will be aiming fast and sure to hit the target.

Gun-swinging **Mika, Indochine, Jamiroquai, M**, hell-raisers **Suprême NTM, Julian Casablancas** will be planning to tell it like it is.

No less will be expected of young guns like the intrepid **Pony Pony Run Run, Gush, FM Belfast, The Black Box Revelation, Fortune, Mildlake and Fanfarlo**. Calamity Jane will just have to hold her horses ! **The Raveonnettes, Sexy Sushi, Diam's and Sophie Hunger** will be making sure that the gals get their look in.

Alongside the gun-toting, hip-swinging, mean-talking oldsters there'll be young'uns at les Vieilles Charrues, **l'Insomniac Noz** somewhere twixt Metal and hardcore, hangin' 'em high with the Aussies **Airbourne**, hopin' that yous ain't gonna get a wink o'sleep.

If ya'll after some'at more tuneful, then you could go for **Toots & The Maytals and Raggasonic**, givin' ya'll a touch of that there reggae-type music and all them sound system types...

Those of ya'll who go in for all that dance and electro music then there's **Boys Noize, DJ Kentaro ou Dan Le Sac vs Scroobius Pip**.

There'll be some new-fangled stuff from **Contréo**, who are hitching up with **Ollivier Leroy** and the 35 musicians of **l'Orchestre de Bretagne** for a creation...

Then there's them there moving **Wonvenhand and Muszikas** brought in last year by the festival's sadly missed friend Kristina Rady.

Beach Box De concert !

There'll be a newcomer to the scene this year in the shape of a new performance space: La Box. Set up by the independent festivals federation De Concert ! La Box puts up and coming talent into the limelight. **69, Brother Ali, Chapelier Fou, Poor Boy et Debruit** have been chosen this year to perform over the three-day period in this space, closer to the audience.

In the more intimate setting of La Garenne, popular with local Breton artists Les Vieilles Charrues will also ensure an emotional experience with street theatre and Breton cabaret. (Programme to be released in May)

Affordable !

A far cry from those festivals who price families out of the market, les Vieilles Charrues has always had an affordable pricing policy.

Three-day passes (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) and day-passes are on sale on les Vieilles Charrues internet site and at the usual sales points and networks.

Prices are as follows:

- 3-day pass 84€
- Thursday only 49€
- One-day tickets 35€ for the Friday, Saturday or Sunday
- Half-price tickets for 9-14 year-olds (proof of identity required)

Which, if you work it out makes it barely 1€ for each show !

The 4-day tickets have already sold out, so don't wait too long before buying your tickets for the rest of the weekend.

As far out West as you can get !

Following last year's inter-galactic extravaganza, Les Vieilles Charrues has chosen to set up camp in the wide open spaces of the Far West this year.

Cow Boys and Amer-Indians will be welcomed with open arms this summer.
